






Guidance for COVID Positive or Exposure: If you have symptoms stay home and get tested

<p>Student/Staff who Test Positive</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Positive individuals must isolate and may return to school after day 5 of quarantine. • Isolation would start after the onset of symptoms (or test date if they had no symptoms) if they are asymptomatic or their symptoms are improving with no fever for 24 hours, followed by 5 days of masking at school. • Positive at-home test accepted as evidence of infection. • PCR tests are preferred for individuals who are asymptomatic (have no symptoms). <p>There is no “testing out” early from the isolation period (first 5 days)</p>
<p>In-Home Exposure Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted OR Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted OR Are unvaccinated</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals must quarantine and may return to school after day 5 of quarantine. Quarantine would start as soon as the positive person was isolated. Upon return to school 5 days of masking at school. • A test is recommended on day 5 of quarantine, do not come to school if waiting on test results • There is no “testing out” early from the quarantine period (first 5 days)
<p>In-Home exposure and student/staff and up-to-date on your COVID-19 vaccine meaning you have been boosted OR you have completed the primary series (both doses) of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine within the last 6 months or you have completed the primary series (single dose) of the J&J vaccine within the last 2 months.</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor for symptoms and mask for 10 days from last exposure • If you become symptomatic stay home and get tested
<p>School Exposure Close Contact (6 feet for 15 minutes)</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor for symptoms and mask for 10 days from last exposure • If you become symptomatic stay home and get tested
<p>Exposed Close Contact, tested positive within the past 90 days, and recovered</p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monitor for symptoms for 10 days and would not need to wear a mask • Must send positive test result showing test date

Daily Screening

I understand that if the answer to any of the foregoing questions on any given day is "Yes," I will not come to campus and will notify the school immediately.

<p>Do you have one of the following?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sudden onset of shortness of breath • Sudden cough • Sudden loss of taste or smell 	<p>Do you have 2+ of the following?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever of over 100.4 °F • Chills longer than two hours • Congestion and/or runny nose • Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea • Sore throat • Headache • Muscle pain 	<p>Have you had close contact with someone positive for COVID-19?</p> <p><i>Close contact means contact longer than 15 minutes within 6 feet without a face covering or residing with someone who is positive.</i></p>	<p>Have you been directed to self-isolate due to a positive COVID-19 result or for having contact with someone with COVID-19?</p> <p><i>If you have had exposure to someone who is being tested</i></p>
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
