- Email: Email is our primary communication channel. Please ensure you have a current email updated in FACTS and on file with the School Office.

- SSM School App: We strongly encourage families to download our school app. It
 includes easy access to a variety of helpful things such as Announcements, the
 Lunch Menu, and more. It is available to download in the Apple & Google Play stores.
 To download, visit your app store and search "SSM School".
- **SSM Google Calendar:** contains all scheduled school activities as well as dress down days and days off. Located here: <u>school.stephen.org/google-calendar</u>. For directions to add it to your personal calendar, visit <u>school.stephen.org/google-calendar-link</u>.

Will I get lots of notifications?

Like all apps, you are able to choose your notification preferences. We keep notifications to a minimum, with only 1 - 2 messages per week. If you choose to turn off notifications, you are still able to see new messages when you open the app.

What is Martyr Marathon?

Martyr Marathon is our school's largest fundraiser of the year (don't worry, no running is involved!). Martyr Marathon replaces the need to do any other fundraising throughout the year for the school. Students are encouraged to collect donations from family, friends, neighbors or businesses to support their school. Donors then pledge a flat donation in support of our school. Students in grades K-8 will participate in an activity-filled course around the school and neighborhood. Students in the early childhood classes will participate in dance parties.

Where will the money go?

Funds collected from this year's Martyr Marathon event will help underwrite the cost of updating restrooms throughout our school and professional development for our teachers. Additional funds raised will be used for new student desks, security upgrades, and technology subscriptions. Your support is an integral part of our success.

How do students collect pledges and raise money?

Reach out to friends, family, and neighbors! We use PledgeStar, an online fundraising tool that makes it easy for your child to request pledges and secure donations from family and friends -both near and far. Additionally, check with your employer to see if they will match your charitable donation!

What is our 2024 fundraising goal?

This year, our All-School Goal is \$90,000 and we know we can do it with your help! If we reach this goal as a school (including Early Childhood students), each student will receive a goal bag full of gift cards, coupons, and other kid-friendly goodies and a day off of school!
